Sponsored Legislation

HB 3 - Law Enforcement

This bill makes Florida the most Law Enforcement friendly state in the country. It creates recruitment bonuses, creates scholarship programs, relocation assistance, adoption benefits for officers who adopt children from the system, veteran assistance programs, creates new health and wellness training programs, encourages new public safety programs in school and designates May 1st as "Law Enforcement Appreciation Day."

Signed by Governor DeSantis, April 1, 2022

HB 1467 - K-12 Education

This bill places term limits on elected school board members and allows for parental participation in selecting instructional materials. It protects students by putting textbooks used for required instruction topics through a rigorous vetting process to ensure that they are age-appropriate, support state academic standards, and allow parental contribution.

Signed by Governor DeSantis, March 25, 2022





HB 1435 - Code and Traffic Enforcement

Allows local law enforcement and municipalities to create special event zones to deal with social media "pop-up" or "invasion" events.
